He completed a three-year residency program at UCSF in prosthodontics in 1979. Since then Dr. Jacobson has maintained a private practice that is devoted to cosmetic, preventive, and prosthetic dentistry, including implants. He is an Associate Clinical Professor in the Department of Restorative Dentistry at UCSF.

Dr. Jacobson is also a member and/or Fellow of the San Francisco Dental Society, California Dental Association, Academy of Prosthodontics, American College of Prosthodontics, Pacific Coast Society of Prosthodontics, and American College of Dentists.
